

Major Changes

- Loop ramps will be removed and replaced with a signalized intersection.
- North Shore Drive will be reduced from two lanes to one lane in each direction.
- Carroll Street to Route 363 access will be removed and terminate at a newly constructed cul-de-sac.
- Construction of a multi-use path along Susquehanna River wall from Washington Street to Rock Bottom Dam.
- More downtown greenspace.

- Construction Complete: Late Fall 2028*

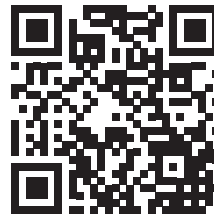

Route 363 and Route 434 Gateway Project Update

Project Objectives

The NY Route 363 and 434 Gateway Project will transform a portion of NY Route 363 into a multimodal corridor for motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians. The project will facilitate access between downtown Binghamton, the Susquehanna River and NY Route 434 by:

- Enhancing safe use for motorized and non-motorized transportation.
- Modifying access to the NY Route 363 corridor between Washington and Carroll streets.
- Constructing a new shared bicycle and pedestrian path and new sidewalks.
- Improving access to Susquehanna River.

Selected Project Alternative

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) has selected **Alternative 1.12 — North Shore Drive Reconfiguration with Signalized Route 434** as the preferred alternative, which meets the project objectives. This project will enhance the multi-modal connectivity and access between downtown Binghamton and the Susquehanna River.
